



TEXCAP Income Eligibility Guidelines July 1, 2007-June 30, 2008

The chart below provides the income limits for households applying to participate in the Texas Commodity Assistance Program (TEXCAP). The income limits are at 185% of federal poverty levels.

The first column lists household sizes. The next three columns provide maximum allowable income limits in annual, monthly, and weekly amounts.

Example: A four-person household with yearly income totaling \$38,203 is eligible. The same household would not be eligible if yearly income totaled \$38,300

An applicant household is **not** eligible for TEXCAP if the household's gross income exceeds:

Note: Use gross income to determine eligibility

Exceptions:

- ▶ Farmers and self-employed households qualify based on net income (total income minus expenses)
- ▶ A household with unexpected and unavoidable expenses of a household crisis may qualify for temporary emergency food assistance without regard to the household gross or net income.
